Stoppage times

We've now finalised the times at which the wedding coach will be picking people up from each of the three stops.

The coach will leave the first stop, Hextable, at **13.00**. This stop is the bus stop opposite the village green, at the bottom of St. David's Road (where Paul's mum and dad live). If you're parking at/near Pat and Dave's house, please arrive there by **12.45**, to allow time to head down the road to the bus stop and pull away at 13.00 sharp!

The second stop will be at King's Cross station. The pick-up time here will be **14.10**. At the moment we are still waiting to hear

exactly where this will be, since King's Cross is quite large so the exact pick-up point could do with some narrowing down!

The third stop will be outside Great Portland Street tube station, where we'll be picking people up at **14.15**.

Both the London stops' times are subject to us not being horribly held up in traffic on the way in, but they are the coach company's best guesses and they're the ones who do this sort of thing all the time so they should be pretty good at estimating! We won't leave before the times stated without everyone though, if we run early.

We'll keep you posted with any further details of exact pick-up locations, so we know where to tell you to stand.

It would also be useful those of you travelling by coach could ensure you have kept their mobile phone numbers up to date on the web site so we can get in touch if you're not at the stop we're expecting to see you at!

There are still five seats remaining on the coach, by the way, so snap them up quickly if you want them!
